

Our focus areas of education and performing arts enable us to touch the lives of countless Buffalonians. Our emphasis the past 10 years has been supporting local nonprofit partners with funding, capacity-building activities, thought partnership, and other means of assistance.

## **\$48 MILLION TO 187 NONPROFITS** PLUS AN ADDITIONAL \$3.4M PLEDGED

Between January 1, 2015 and April 1, 2025 we provided **\$48 million** in cash grant payments to **187 nonprofit organizations** working in Western New York communities. As of April 1, 2025, **an additional \$3.4 million** in cash grants is firmly committed toward future grant payments with much more to follow.
