Students seeking a unique and rewarding academic experience provided by Erie County's private schools (BISON Fund and EdCo networks) have an exciting opportunity. The



Cullen Foundation seeks to assist families of high-achieving students mitigate the financial challenges of attaining a private middle school and high school education through our Cullen Scholars program.

Values

The Cullen Foundation believes that access to high quality education is critical for an individual and a community's success. To this end, we are providing an opportunity to a select group of high-performing students entering



grade 5 to attend a private school in the BISON Fund network. Cullen Scholars also participate in Buffalo Prep, which offers students arts-integrated, academic enrichment experiences throughout the year.

Our program provides access to private schools with preference given to students of color. We offer this opportunity to high-achieving students while increasing the diversity of experience for all private school students. Cullen Scholars will be selected based on academic achievement, financial need, and character.

Eligibility

- Student is in good standing with a "B" or above average.
- Student's family meets household income criteria, demonstrating financial need (visit the Cullen Foundation website for more information).
- Student must be an Erie County resident.
- Student is nominated by a BISON Fund school.
- Students will be required to participate in Buffalo Prep.
- Preference is given to students of color.

Application and Process Middle School Scholarship

Applications must be completed in partnership with a BISON Fund school. The applicant will work with the guidance counselor/administrator at the BISON Fund school to access and complete an application.

- Each BISON Fund school may nominate one 4th grade student for a middle school scholarship.
- Scholarships are partial and renewable for up to eight years while the student attends a BISON Fund/EdCo school, contingent on meeting our academic and financial criteria each year.
- Applications are due by February 7th.
- A committee comprised of community volunteers will review the applications and choose the scholarship winners.
